IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Abstracts should be submitted electronically via the abstract submission portal.
- Abstracts should be based on original research, systematic reviews, clinical audits, case series or case reports related to paediatrics.
- Each submitting author is permitted to submit a maximum of three (3) abstracts.
- The presenting author should register with the congress within one-month of being informed of the acceptance of the abstract.
- The author/s should take full intellectual responsibility for the work described in the submitted abstract.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINE

All Abstract submissions should conform to the following requirements and specifications.

- Language: All abstracts should be written in English (UK)
- Title: The title of the abstract should be concise but informative
- Authors: The author names should appear as first name followed by the surname. E.g. Andrew Smith
- **Affiliations:** Author affiliations should include the institution, city and the country at the time of conducting the research (Designations should not be included).
- **Presenting author:** Name, address, telephone number and email address of the presenting author should be clearly indicated
- **Structure of research abstracts:** Abstracts of original research, systematic reviews and clinical audits should be structured under the following sub-headings.
 - (I) Introduction (II) Objectives (III) Methods
 - (IV) Results (V) Conclusions
- **Structure of case reports:** Abstracts of case series and case reports should be structured under the following sub-headings.
 - (I) Introduction (II) Case presentation (III) Conclusions
- **Word limit:** The text of the abstract should not exceed 250 words. Tables, figures or references should not be included in the abstract.

Once submitted, no revisions or alterations, including changing of the names of authors, would be permitted.
